Religious Education/Sacramental Preparation OUTLINE

The Big Question: Where does my child belong in St. Joan of Arc's Religious education process?

The Big Answer: Excellent! Sometimes there can be a fair amount of confusion surrounding this question, so allow us to help. We have a three-year RE/Sacramental Prep process designed to help entire families grow in their Catholic faith together. So often parishes will do a wonderful job catechizing the younger generation, but if parents do not know their faith, or fail to practice at home, it's unlikely the child's own faith will prosper. Naturally, we don't want that to happen. Rather, it is the Church's desire that every recipient of the grace of Baptism be faithful followers of Jesus Christ their entire lives; but for that to happen, mom and dad, themselves, must be living out the ideal, and modeling it to their children. In this, it is the parish's responsibility to help parents fulfill what they promised at the time of their child's Baptism. The three-year process outlined below is how this parish chooses to fulfill that responsibility.

Please find below an outline of our three-year program.

Year A: Parent Evangelization & Catechesis

All new incoming parents desiring sacramental preparation for their child are required to attend a year-long adult religious education class before sending their child to the parish for instruction. The classes meet weekly for two hours, and at least one parent is expected to attend regularly. Dates and times of classes will be provided upon registration.

Year B: Parent & Child Evangelization/Catechesis

Returning for their second year of instruction, parents may now enroll their child in religious education classes. Typically, this first year of in-class instruction for the child is spent presenting them with a more complete picture of salvation history, in addition to preparing them for the sacrament of Reconciliation.

Year C: Parent & Child Evangelization/Catechesis

Returning for a third year of instruction, parents may once again enroll their child in religious education classes, leading to their Confirmation and First Eucharist.

Family Sacrament Policy Agreement

Congratulations! You are now registering your child for sacraments at St. Joan of Arc. This is a momentous time in the life of your family. So in order to ensure that each child is ready to receive his sacrament(s), we ask that you review the following information. It is important that you, as primary educators, are aware of all requirements up front, so that your child's preparation can be truly meaningful, and not marred by anxiety or last minute pressures. The following agreement exists in order to provide our families with the most fruitful sacramental experience possible. Therefore, careful compliance with the requirements below will allow us to work together in making this a season of true spiritual growth.

Please initial each promise/acknowledgement and then sign below. This form must be completed before your child may register. 1. _____ I promise God and my pastor that my family and I will attend Holy Mass every Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation? 2. _____ I promise God and my pastor that that I and/or my spouse (if applicable) will attend all Parent Enrichment Classes held on a weekly basis at St. Joan of Arc, save for in times of emergency. 3. ______ I promise God and my pastor that I will not neglect my role as "primary educator" of my children, particularly as regards to the authentic living out of my own Catholic faith. 4. ______ I promise God and my pastor that I will teach my children the Ten Commandments; the Lord's Prayer; the Hail Mary, The Glory Be; the Act of Contrition and The Nicene Creed. 5. ______ I promise God and my pastor (save for in an emergency) that my family will attend all Family Nights. Dates can be found in registration packet. Lacknowledge that my child will be given a sacrament assessment prior to the reception of the sacrament date. The cost will be approximately \$130. (NOTE: Please start saving for this event now).
