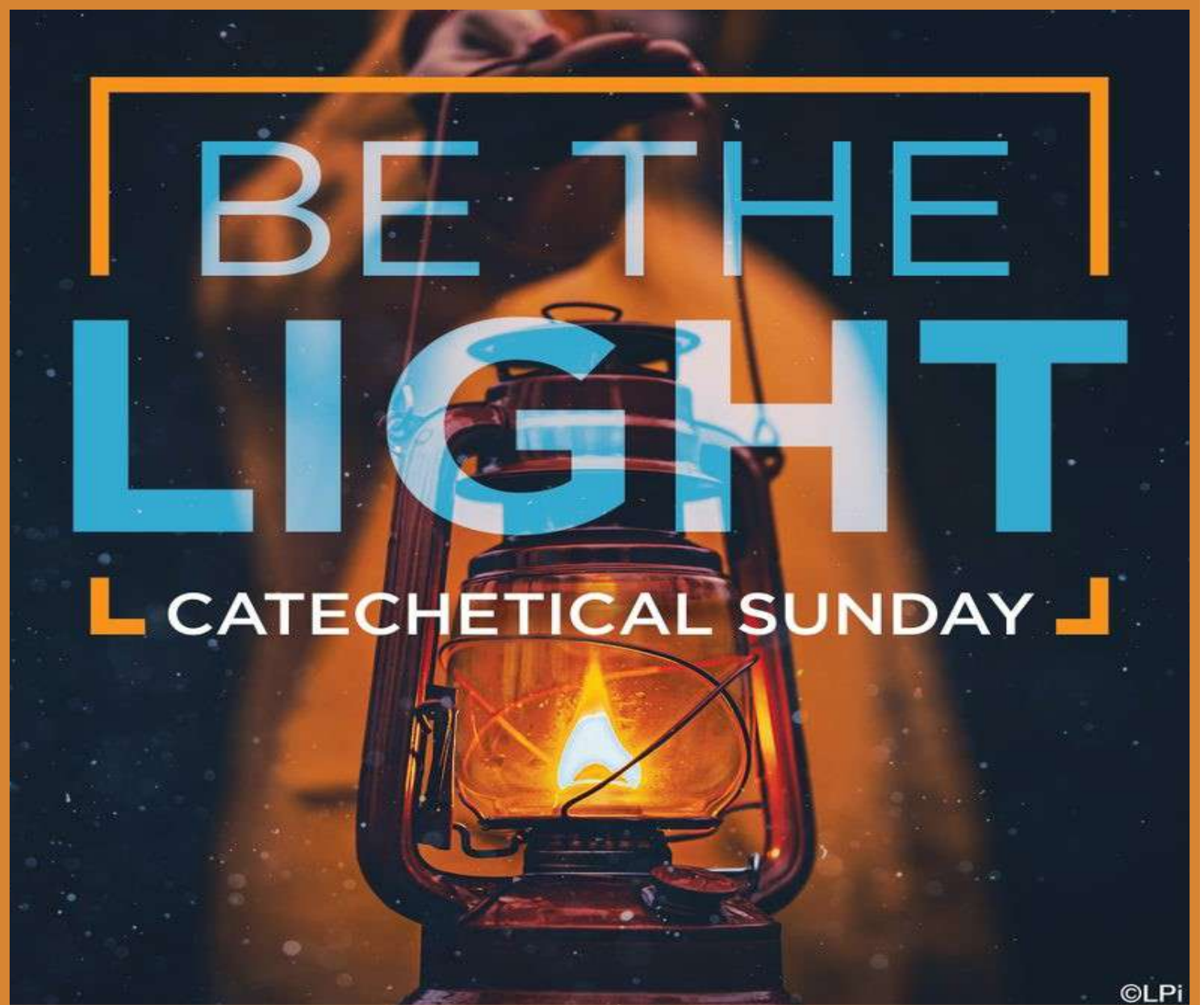

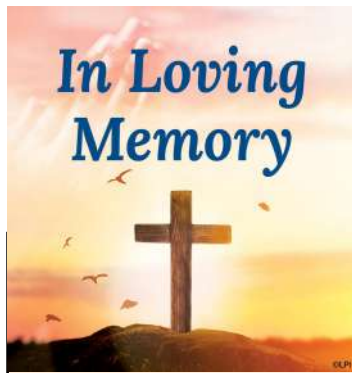

Hello,

It must just happen as we grow older. The world changes and we begin to feel out of place. I remember the first “smart” phone I saw and now just about everything can be done or is done over the phone. I do use the phone for maps; I’ve changed that much. When I was a boy we had pay phones on street corners and all over the place and I read a paper map if I wanted to know how to get somewhere or I asked someone for directions. This is just one example, but the point is that things change and we have to adjust and sometimes it is hard to adjust. Many of you may be saying to me, welcome kid. All right, I am kind of complaining, but I am also just noticing and wanting to make another point.

In the scriptures we read that *“here we have no lasting city, but we seek the city which is to come”* (Hebrews 13:14). This is not our final home; that is heaven. And so, while we are here, no wonder we feel a little out of place. This feeling that I am talking about is not just part of growing older; it is part of our faith. When we look at the world all around us and feel that in some basic way we don’t belong here, or we don’t recognize things anymore, this is the pull of our faith leading us onward to our heavenly home. And we do long for it. We want a place of permanence. This is why we love traditions so much, precisely because they do not change.

I think this is the main reason we love Mass so much and come week after week to celebrate Mass together. This is our main tradition. This is our anchor in a changing and upturned world. It is also our taste of heaven. When we are in the church and the music is playing and the words are said and then we can come forward and receive communion – this is our taste of heaven. One day it will come fully.
