Happy Sunday!

How shall we live? Our Sunday readings invite us to form our hearts and minds in freedom toward the good that leads to life. "If you choose, you can keep the commandments; they will save you" (Sir 15:15). The Lord sets before us fire and water, life and death, blessing and curse. This is the dignity of being able to cooperate with God's wisdom rather than being ruled by impulse or fear.



Saint Paul deepens this insight when he tells the Corinthians that true wisdom is not the wisdom of the world but the hidden wisdom of God, revealed by the Holy Spirit. We cannot live rightly by our own cleverness alone, we need the light of God who "searches everything, even the depths of God" (1 Cor 2:10). Our Catholic moral life flows from this divine wisdom, which illumines our conscience and helps us recognize the good that truly leads to happiness.

One evening my priest friend reminisced about our moral theology teacher, an adamant defender of *Veritatis Splendor* and specifically paragraph 78 which reminds us that the morality of a human act depends primarily on the object chosen by the deliberate will, as Saint Thomas Aquinas so wisely taught. In other words, what we choose, not only our feelings or intentions, truly matters. Good intentions cannot make a wrong choice good, rather, our freedom is most authentic when it is ordered toward what is truly good. When reflecting on our Gospel, our Blessed Lord does not abolish the Law, He fulfills it. In Matthew's Sermon on the Mount, He takes us beyond a superficial reading of the commandments and reveals their deepest intention. It is not enough to avoid murder, we must guard our hearts against anger and contempt. It is not enough to avoid adultery, we must cultivate purity of heart. It is not enough to keep oaths, we must be people of integrity whose "yes" means yes and whose "no" means no. Christ invites us to an interior conversion where our choices, our desires, and our loves are aligned with God's truth.

For us as a parish, this has concrete implications. Our good consciences are formed through prayer, Scripture, the Sacraments, and the Church's teaching, so that our choices in family life, work, civic engagement, and daily relationships reflect the wisdom of Christ rather than the passing standards of the world. The Eucharist we celebrate each week is both the source and summit of this moral life, strengthening us to choose love, mercy, and truth.

Come Holy Spirit! Purify our hearts, enlighten our minds, and strengthen our wills.

¡Feliz domingo!

¿Cómo debemos vivir? Las lecturas del domingo nos invitan a formar nuestros corazones y mentes en libertad hacia el bien que conduce a la vida. "Si tú lo quieres, puedes guardar los mandamientos; ellos te salvarán" (Sir 15, 15). El Señor nos pone ante nosotros el fuego y el agua, la vida y la muerte, la bendición y la maldición. Esta es la dignidad de poder cooperar con la sabiduría de Dios en lugar de dejarnos dominar por los impulsos o el miedo.

San Pablo profundiza en esta idea cuando dice a los corintios que la verdadera sabiduría no es la sabiduría del mundo, sino la sabiduría oculta de Dios, revelada por el Espíritu Santo. No podemos vivir correctamente solo con nuestra propia inteligencia, necesitamos la luz de Dios. "Dios nos lo ha revelado por el Espíritu que conoce perfectamente todo, hasta lo más profundo de Dios" (1 Cor 2, 10). Nuestra vida moral católica brota de esta sabiduría divina, que ilumina nuestra conciencia y nos ayuda a reconocer el bien que verdaderamente conduce a la felicidad.

Una noche, mi amigo sacerdote recordó a nuestro profesor de teología moral, un defensor acérrimo de *Veritatis Splendor* y, en concreto, del párrafo 78, que nos recuerda que la moralidad de un acto humano depende principalmente del objeto elegido por la voluntad deliberada, como tan sabiamente enseñó Santo Tomás de Aquino. En otras palabras, lo que elegimos, y no solo nuestros sentimientos o intenciones, es lo que realmente importa. Las buenas intenciones no pueden convertir una mala elección en buena, sino que nuestra libertad es más auténtica cuando se orienta hacia lo que es verdaderamente bueno. Al reflexionar sobre nuestro Evangelio, nuestro Señor no abole la Ley, sino que la cumple. En el Sermón de la Montaña de Mateo, nos lleva más allá de una lectura superficial de los mandamientos y nos revela su intención más profunda. No basta con evitar el asesinato, debemos proteger nuestro corazón contra la ira y el desprecio. No basta con evitar el adulterio, debemos cultivar la pureza de corazón. No basta con cumplir los juramentos, debemos ser personas íntegras cuyo «sí» significa sí y cuyo «no» significa no. Cristo nos invita a una conversión interior en la que nuestras elecciones, nuestros deseos y nuestros amores estén alineados con la verdad de Dios.

Para nosotros, como parroquia, esto tiene implicaciones concretas. Nuestra buena conciencia se forma a través de la oración, las Escrituras, los sacramentos y las enseñanzas de la Iglesia, de modo que nuestras decisiones en la vida familiar, el trabajo, el compromiso cívico y las relaciones cotidianas reflejen la sabiduría de Cristo en lugar de las normas pasajeras del mundo. La Eucaristía que celebramos cada semana es tanto la fuente como la cumbre de esta vida moral, fortaleciéndonos para elegir el amor, la misericordia y la verdad.

¡Ven, Espíritu Santo! Purifica nuestros corazones, ilumina nuestras mentes y fortalece nuestras voluntades.
