THE 4TH SUNDAY OF LENT—MARCH 15, 2026

Happy Laetare Sunday!

The Church invites us to rejoice during our penitential journey. The rose vestments remind us that Easter's light draws near, even as we continue our Lenten disciplines. Today's Gospel from John 9:1-41 presents the healing of the man born blind, a profound story of physical sight restored, spiritual vision awakened, and the challenge to see Christ truly as the light of the world. This narrative, prescribed for the second scrutiny of our elect preparing for Baptism at Easter, calls us all to examine our own blindness and embrace the joy of divine illumination.

Our Blessed Lord encounters a man blind from birth and with mud from his saliva, Jesus sends the man to wash in the Pool of Siloam, "which means Sent," and he returns seeing. This miracle unfolds surrounded by controversy. Neighbors question, Pharisees investigate on the Sabbath, and even the man's parents fear expulsion from the synagogue. Yet the healed man's faith grows from "the man called Jesus" to "a prophet," and finally, "I do believe, Lord, and he worshiped him." The blind man's vision increases by admitting his arrogance in humility and progressing to full faith! Meanwhile, the Pharisees grow blinder by denying the miracle they cannot explain. This is a revelation of Christ's power, inviting us to wash in the waters of faith and see God's works active in our lives.

Our Elect, those to be baptized this Easter are undergoing the second scrutiny with exorcisms and intercessions. They are receiving solemn prayers from us, the assembly before dismissal emphasizing their hunger for the Eucharist they soon will share. Join me in supporting them! Your prayers during this scrutiny strengthen their resistance to sin and openness to Christ's light.

One final note, I humbly ask of your prayers as I go on a mission trip to Honduras with the University of Southern California FOCUS students. I'll return on March 22nd, just in time for our parish mission on March 23rd and March 24th.

La Iglesia nos invita a regocijarnos durante nuestro camino penitencial. Las vestiduras rosadas nos recuerdan que la luz de la Pascua se acerca, incluso mientras continuamos con nuestras disciplinas cuaresmales. El Evangelio de hoy, tomado de Juan 9, 1-41, presenta la curación del ciego de nacimiento, una profunda historia sobre la recuperación de la vista física, el despertar de la visión espiritual y el reto de ver a Cristo verdaderamente como la luz del mundo. Esta narración, prescrita para el segundo escrutinio de nuestros elegidos que se preparan para el Bautismo en Pascua, nos llama a todos a examinar nuestra propia ceguera y a abrazar la alegría de la iluminación divina.

Nuestro Señor se encuentra con un hombre ciego de nacimiento y, con barro de su saliva, Jesús envía al hombre a lavarse en el estanque de Siloé, "que significa Enviado", y él regresa viendo. Este milagro se desarrolla rodeado de controversia. Los vecinos cuestionan, los fariseos investigan en sábado e incluso los padres del hombre temen ser expulsados de la sinagoga. Sin embargo, la fe del hombre curado crece desde "el hombre llamado Jesús" hasta "un profeta" y, finalmente, "Creo, Señor", y lo adoró. ¡La visión del ciego aumenta al admitir su arrogancia con humildad y progresar hacia la fe plena! Mientras tanto, los fariseos se vuelven más ciegos al negar el milagro que no pueden explicar. Esta es una revelación del poder de Cristo, que nos invita a lavarnos en las aguas de la fe y ver las obras de Dios activas en nuestras vidas.

Nuestros elegidos, aquellos que serán bautizados esta Pascua, están pasando por el segundo escrutinio con exorcismos e intercesiones. Están recibiendo nuestras oraciones solemnes, y la asamblea, antes de la despedida, enfatiza su anhelo por la Eucaristía que pronto compartirán. ¡Únanse a mí para apoyarlos! Sus oraciones durante este escrutinio fortalecen su resistencia al pecado y su apertura a la luz de Cristo.

Una última nota: les pido humildemente sus oraciones, ya que voy a realizar un viaje misionero a Honduras con los estudiantes de FOCUS de la Universidad del Sur de California. Regresaré el 22 de marzo, justo a tiempo para nuestra misión parroquial del 23 y 24 de marzo.
