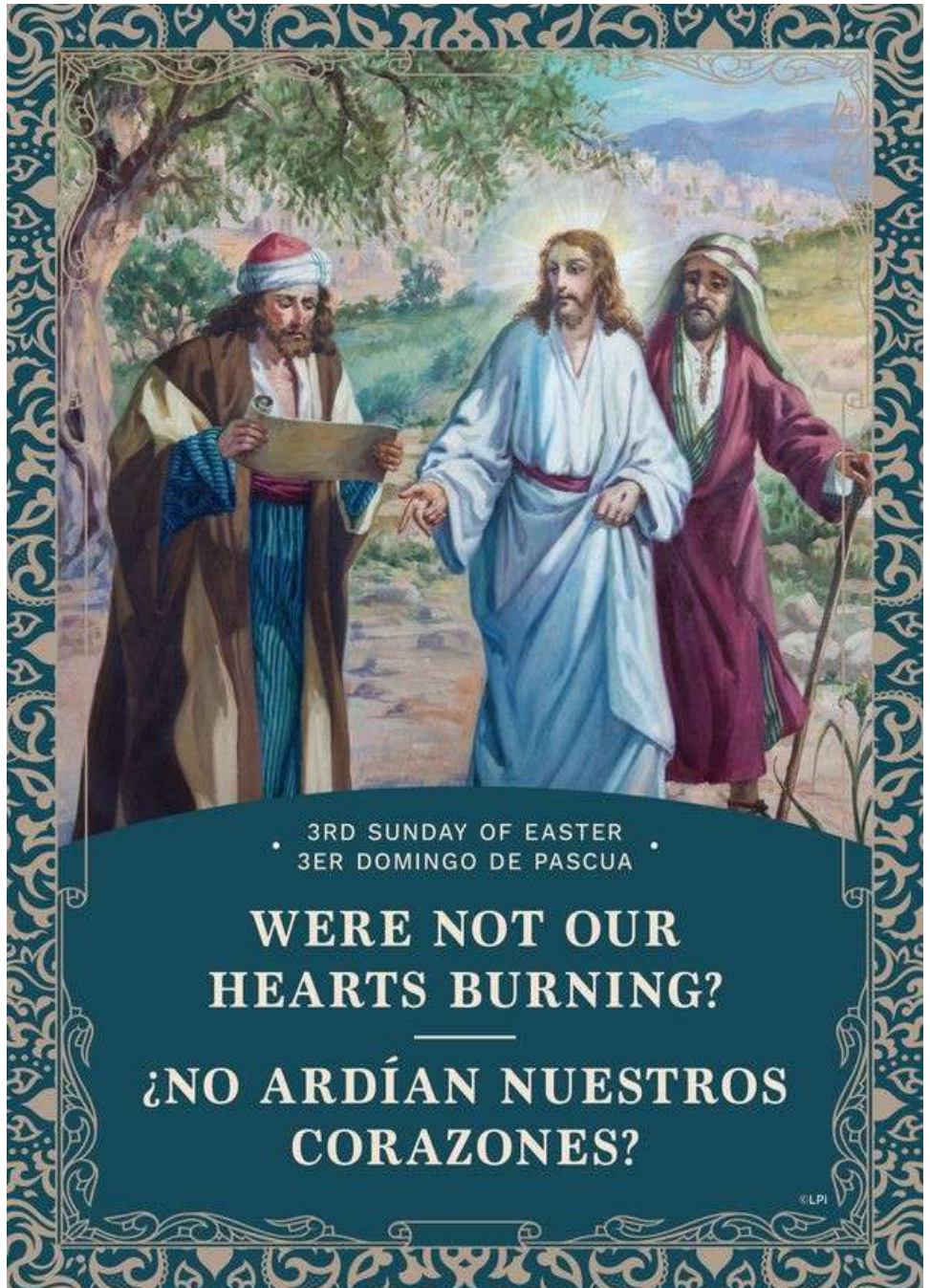

FROM THE PASTOR



Happy Easter!

Our Easter season continues with the bold proclamation of Saint Peter saying Christ has risen in the Acts of the Apostles and the two disciples' hearts are set on fire when our Blessed Lord walks with them. Both passages address the same human struggle when life is heavy, we can become discouraged, confused, or *"slow of heart."* *The Lord does not leave us there. He comes near, speaks, and makes Himself known.*

In Jerusalem, Saint Peter is changed by raising his voice and speaking directly to his people. As he acknowledged the tragedy of the crucifixion, he centered our attention on our Christian joy, *"God raised this Jesus; of this we are all witnesses."* *So Saint Peter's proclamation is not merely historical information, it is a call to faith in God's action. God has the last word, even over betrayal, suffering, and apparent defeat.*

The Gospel of Luke shows the same truth from the inside. The two disciples walked away from hope on the road to Emmaus. *"They stopped, looking downcast."* and our Blessed Lord comes alongside them, asking what they are discussing. *Their sorrow is real, but our Blessed Lord will not let their sadness become their final story as he tells them: "Oh, how foolish you are! How slow of heart to believe all that the prophets spoke! Was it not necessary that the Christ should suffer these things and enter into his glory?"*

Sometimes, after hard weeks of discouragement, conflict, or unanswered prayers, we start living as if the story ended at Calvary. Acts and Emmaus challenge that instinct. Our Lord comes near your walk, He opens the scriptures to your heart and mind, He is recognized in the breaking of the bread and then joy becomes active. *!Were not our hearts burning within us while he spoke to us on the way and opened the Scriptures to us?" Don't keep the Risen Lord private and tucked away in the back of your mind. Christian joy always tends towards witness!*

¡Feliz Pascuas!

Nuestra temporada de Pascua continúa con la valiente proclamación de San Pedro en los Hechos de los Apóstoles, en la que afirma que Cristo ha resucitado, y con el momento en que los corazones de los dos discípulos se llenan de entusiasmo cuando nuestro Señor camina con ellos. Ambos pasajes abordan la misma lucha humana: cuando la vida se vuelve pesada, podemos sentirnos desanimados, confundidos o *"duros de corazón."* *El Señor no nos deja así. Se acerca a nosotros, nos habla y se da a conocer.*

En Jerusalén, San Pedro se transforma al alzar la voz y dirigirse directamente a su pueblo. Al reconocer la tragedia de la crucifixión, centró nuestra atención en nuestra alegría cristiana: *"A este Jesús Dios lo resucitó, y de ello todos nosotros somos testigos."* *Así pues, la proclamación de San Pedro no es meramente una información histórica, sino una llamada a la fe en la acción de Dios. Dios tiene la última palabra, incluso sobre la traición, el sufrimiento y la aparente derrota.*

El Evangelio de Lucas muestra la misma verdad desde dentro. Los dos discípulos se alejaban de la esperanza en el camino a Emaús. *"Tan llenos de tristeza"*, y nuestro Señor se acerca a ellos y les pregunta de qué están hablando. *Su dolor es real, pero nuestro Señor no permitirá que su tristeza se convierta en su historia final, pues les dice: "¡Qué insensatos son ustedes y qué duros de corazón para creer todo lo anunciado por los profetas! ¿Acaso no era necesario que el Mesías padeciera todo esto y así entrara en su gloria?"*

A veces, tras semanas difíciles de desánimo, conflictos o oraciones sin respuesta, empezamos a vivir como si la historia hubiera terminado en el Calvario. Los Hechos de los Apóstoles y el episodio de Emaús desafían ese instinto. Nuestro Señor se acerca a tu camino, te abre las Escrituras al corazón y a la mente, se le reconoce al partir el pan y entonces la alegría cobra vida. *"¡Con razón nuestro corazón ardía, mientras nos hablaba por el camino y nos explicaba las Escrituras!" No mantengas al Señor Resucitado en privado y escondido en lo más profundo de tu mente. ¡La alegría cristiana siempre tiende al testimonio!*
