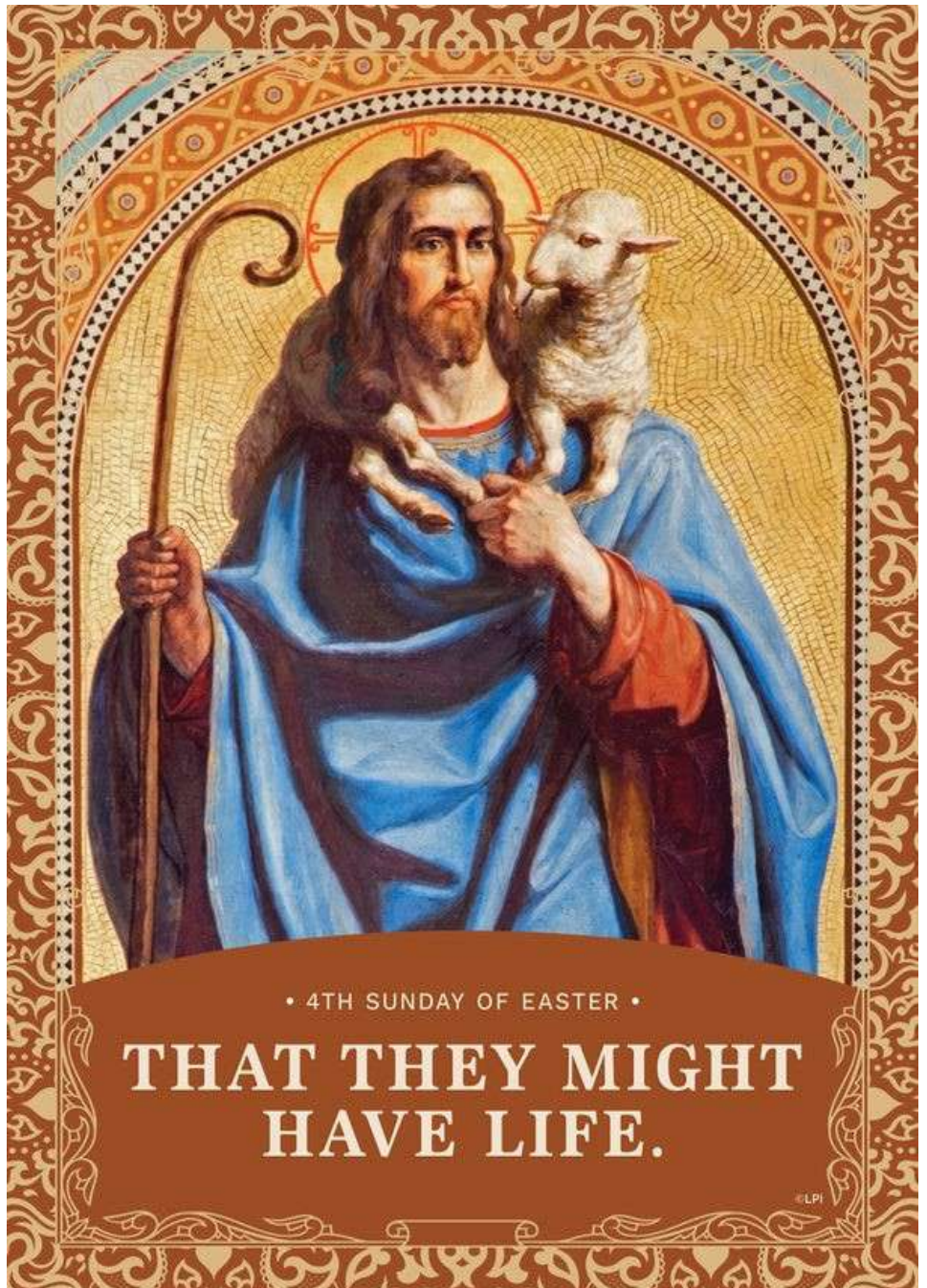

A LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR



Happy Easter!

During this week, we remember priestly vocations as we listen to the voice of Jesus, our Good Shepherd, and to pray for more men to enter the priesthood. Listening is important because Jesus provides a distinct contrast between the false shepherd and good shepherd. The false shepherd comes to steal, kill, and destroy, while He comes to give life “in abundance.”

When our Lord says, “I am the gate,” He is saying that saving life passes through Him. Through the ministry of the priesthood, men are called to serve the truth in a visible and sacramental way so that Christ Himself may care for His flock through the ministry entrusted to the church.

Our parish is blessed to have two seminarians preparing for the priesthood, David Wilmowski and newly accepted John Miller. Thank you for the prayers and continued support of these men as they continue formation to be formed like Christ. Pope Saint John Paul II asked the Church to pray “the Lord of the harvest to send out labourers into his harvest,” calling for “earnest prayer” so that the Church may have “faithful priests and holy religious.”

Please pray daily for vocations, especially for young men discerning the priesthood. Encourage with charity as the Lord calls someone, as our parish families and community are willing to offer prayerful support.

Esta semana, reflexionamos sobre las vocaciones sacerdotales mientras escuchamos la voz de Jesús, nuestro Buen Pastor, y rezamos para que más hombres se incorporen al sacerdocio. Escuchar es importante porque Jesús establece una clara distinción entre el falso pastor y el buen pastor. El falso pastor viene a robar, matar y destruir, mientras que Él viene a dar vida “en abundancia.”

Cuando nuestro Señor dice: “Yo soy la puerta,” está diciendo que la vida salvadora pasa a través de Él. A través del ministerio sacerdotal, los hombres están llamados a servir a la verdad de manera visible y sacramental, para que Cristo mismo pueda cuidar de su rebaño a través del ministerio confiado a la Iglesia.

Nuestra parroquia tiene la bendición de contar con dos seminaristas que se preparan para el sacerdocio: David Wilmowski y John Miller, recién admitido. Gracias por las oraciones y el apoyo constante a estos hombres mientras continúan su formación para ser conformados a Cristo.
