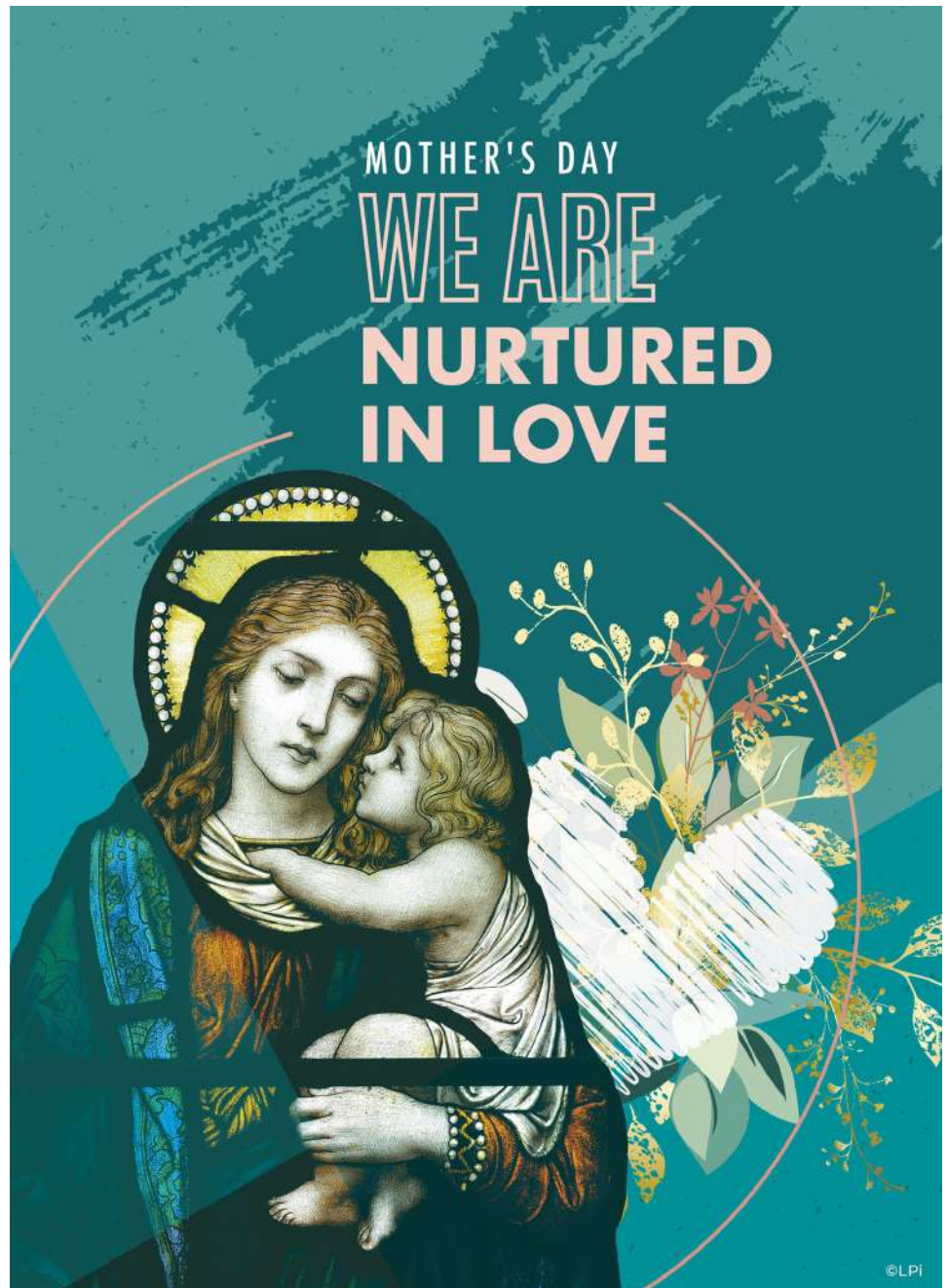

A LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR



GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

May 10, 2026
6th Sunday of Easter

John 14:15-21

In my family, we can hardly speak about orphans without tears. My father was adopted as a baby. He frequently told us stories of how his parents welcomed him not just into their home but into their hearts. It was never merely a relocation or a legal transaction. It was the joy of being chosen, of receiving a family, a name, and a place where he belonged forever. Even in his later years, recalling that gift still moves him to tears of tender gratitude.

That is the kind of tenderness behind Jesus' words in today's Gospel: "I will not leave you orphans; I will come to you." (John 14:18) He is going away, but not abandoning us. Instead, he sends us the Advocate, the Holy Spirit — his own Spirit, shared with the Father — who dwells in us. Through the Spirit, Christ is present in us, and we are present in him. His Spirit gives us a home and a family.

We deepen this knowledge in the sacraments, in prayer, and in the daily life of the Church. The Spirit is the bond of belonging, the power that makes us God's sons and daughters, not spiritual orphans. And this is not a one-time event. There is always a deeper outpouring of the Spirit available to us, a fresh appropriation of the promise that we are never abandoned. If only we could be as grateful as my dad is for his adoption, realizing that we have been adopted by God Himself. In Christ, we are never left as orphans.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO – ALENTAR UN ENTENDIMIENTO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA

10 de mayo de 2026
VI Domingo de Pascua

Juan 14:15-21

Las palabras de Jesús en la liturgia de hoy son como un testamento que se cumple con la llegada del Consolador: "Si ustedes me aman, guardarán mis mandamientos, y yo rogaré al Padre y les dará otro Protector que permanecerá siempre con ustedes" (Juan 14:15). ¿Qué nos toca cumplir a nosotros ante la petición de Jesús? Solamente una cosa: cumplir los mandamientos; es decir, vivir según el Evangelio, siendo caritativos y generosos. Aunque nos cueste dejar el egoísmo, la misericordia puede vencer por medio del amor.

"Cuántas personas se han alejado, por ejemplo, de la parroquia o comunidad por el ambiente de habladorías, de celos, de envidias que han encontrado. También para un cristiano, el saber amar no es un dato adquirido una vez para siempre; hay que volver a empezar cada día, hay que ejercitarse para que nuestro amor hacia los hermanos y hermanas que encontramos se vuelva maduro y purificado de aquellos límites o pecados que lo hacen parcial, egoísta, estéril e infiel. Cada día se debe aprender el arte de amar" (Papa Francisco, 21 de mayo de 2017). Más claro que el agua no puede ser: el Espíritu Santo nos acompaña, y la muestra de nuestro amor a Jesús está en practicar los mandamientos. Pidámosle a Jesús que nos ayude con su gracia a ser dóciles a la voz de Dios. La vida es difícil; se presentan muchas cosas cada día, pero por lo menos seamos coherentes en la fe.

St. Michael Prayer, Explained

The prayer to St. Michael invokes the protection of the archangel Michael in the ongoing spiritual battle for the souls of all mankind. This prayer was composed by Pope Leo XIII and its use was instituted in 1886 at the end of Low Mass, a tradition which continued until the liturgical reforms of the Second Vatican Council. A popular story regarding its origin claims that the Pope wrote this prayer after having a vision of demonic spirits descending on Rome.

Michael is mentioned as one of God's seven archangels in the Book of Enoch and is presented by Revelations 12:7-12 as the warrior angel who cast Satan from heaven. He is therefore traditionally venerated as a protector against the forces of evil and a guardian of the Church.

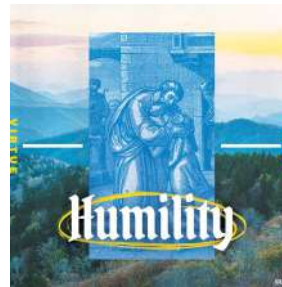

Novena to Saint Joan of Arc

Glorious Saint Joan of Arc, filled with compassion for those who invoke you, with love for those who suffer, heavily laden with the weight of my troubles, I kneel at your feet and humbly beg you to take my present need under your special protection [state intention here].

Vouchsafe to recommend it to the Blessed Virgin Mary, and lay it before the throne of Jesus. Cease not to intercede for me until my request is granted.

**Above all, obtain for me the grace to one day meet God face to face and with you and Mary and all the angels and saints praise Him through all eternity. O most powerful Saint Joan, do not let me lose my soul, but obtain for me the grace of winning my way to heaven, forever and ever.
Amen.**

St. Joan of Arc | May 30

St. Joan of Arc (1412 – 1431) has had her story told throughout history through many books, movies and plays. She was born in the village of Domrémy, near the province of Lorraine, to a French peasant family. At a young age, she began to experience visions and voices, which were later identified to be of St. Michael, St. Catherine of Alexandria, and St. Margaret of Antioch. At the age of 13, all three saints told her that she was to drive the English from French territory, and that she must bring the Dauphin to Reims for his coronation. Trusting in God, she did as she was told.

During the Hundred Years War, St. Joan of Arc led French troops against the English and recaptured the cities of Orléans and Troyes. Captured near Compiègne the following year, she was sold to the English and placed on trial for heresy and witchcraft, eventually being found guilty and burned at the stake in Rouen.

St. Joan of Arc was canonized by Pope Benedict XV on May 16, 1920, and is the patron saint of military members.

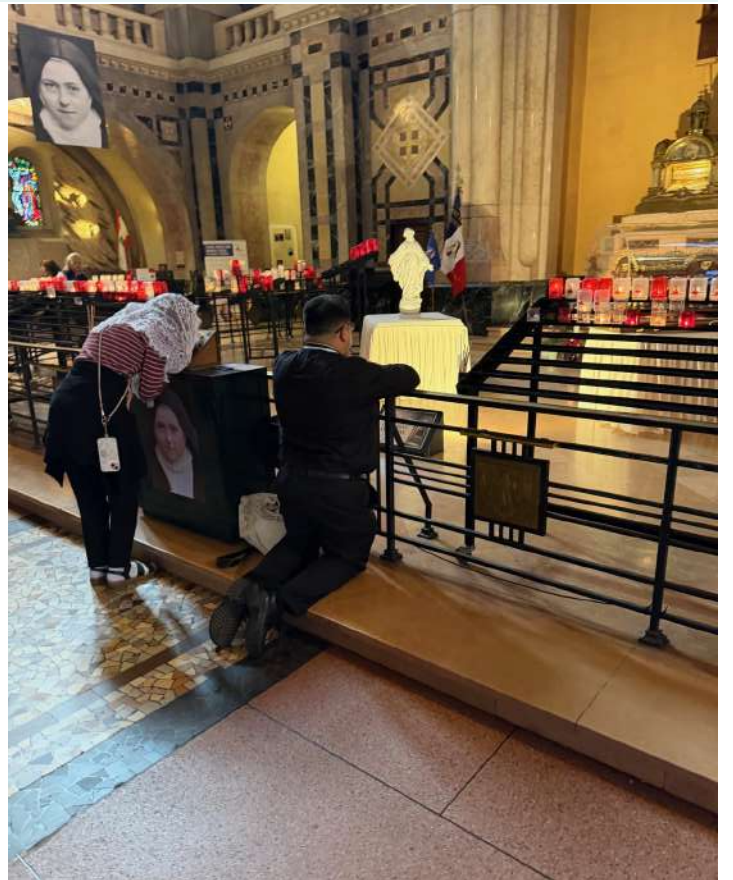

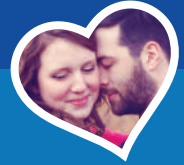

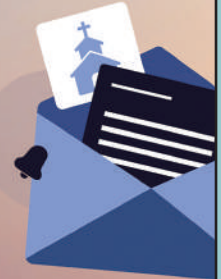
