A LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Happy Trinity Sunday!

This Most Holy Trinity Sunday invites us to stand in awe before the God who saves us in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The Gospel message begins with the love of God for “the world.” The heart of our faith is not fear, but confidence born of God’s saving action in Jesus Christ.



On this day, the Church also turns our attention to what it means to belong to God. The Trinitarian baptismal formula in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit is meant to express that Christian baptism inserts the person into the Trinity and distinguishes Christian baptism from other rites. Because Baptism is a sacrament entrusted by Christ, the Church teaches that the words matter. The Congregation for the Doctrine of the Faith states clearly that Baptism “conferred in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit” conforms to Christ’s command, and that “the Church has no right to change what Christ himself has instituted.” Therefore, “any Baptism is invalid when it does not contain the invocation of the Most Holy Trinity, with the distinct expression of the three Persons with their respective names.” The Church further teaches that the liturgical formulas do not offer alternatives to those terms; they are “words of faith” through which the sacrament’s meaning is expressed and safeguarded. By virtue of our baptism, we live with the presence of the Holy Trinity in our lives.

On this Trinity Sunday, let each family take a moment to thank God for the grace of Baptism, whether received in infancy or later in life. May we believe in Christ with hearts that welcome His saving love, and may our lives increasingly reflect the communion of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.

¡Feliz Domingo de la Santísima Trinidad!



Este Domingo de la Santísima Trinidad nos invita a postrarnos con reverencia ante el Dios que nos salva en el nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. El mensaje del Evangelio comienza con el amor de Dios por “el mundo”. El corazón de nuestra fe no es el miedo, sino la confianza que nace de la acción salvadora de Dios en Jesucristo.

En este día, la Iglesia también nos invita a reflexionar sobre lo que significa pertenecer a Dios. La fórmula bautismal trinitaria “en el nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo” tiene por objeto expresar que el bautismo cristiano inserta a la persona en la Trinidad y distingue al bautismo cristiano de otros ritos. Dado que el bautismo es un sacramento confiado por Cristo, la Iglesia enseña que las palabras son importantes. La Congregación para la Doctrina de la Fe afirma claramente que el bautismo “concedido en el nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo” se ajusta al mandato de Cristo, y que “la Iglesia no tiene derecho a cambiar lo que Cristo mismo ha instituido.” Por lo tanto, “cualquier bautismo es inválido cuando no contiene la invocación de la Santísima Trinidad, con la expresión distinta de las tres Personas con sus respectivos nombres.” La Iglesia enseña además que las fórmulas litúrgicas no ofrecen alternativas a esos términos; son “palabras de fe” a través de las cuales se expresa y salvaguarda el significado del sacramento. En virtud de nuestro bautismo, vivimos con la presencia de la Santísima Trinidad en nuestras vidas.

En este Domingo de la Trinidad, que cada familia se tome un momento para agradecer a Dios la gracia del Bautismo, ya sea que lo haya recibido en la infancia o más tarde en la vida. Que creamos en Cristo con corazones que acogen Su amor salvador, y que nuestras vidas reflejen cada vez más la comunión del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo.

Virtues, Explained! Generosity

Generosity, Explained!

In the early Church, we read in the Acts of the Apostles, "all who believed were together and had all things in common; and they sold their possessions and goods and distributed them to all, as any had need." (Acts 2:44-45)

This doesn't mean we are obligated to sell our homes and cars, move in with our fellow parishioners and split the water bill. But it certainly does describe the spirit with which we must live as Christians — and it is a generous spirit, a spirit of self-denial, a spirit that prioritizes the welfare of our brothers and sisters as it does our own.

Generosity is a fruit of the Holy Spirit, cultivated in our hearts by a closeness to the sacraments and a persistence in prayer: "The one who provides seed for sowing and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed and increase the harvest of your righteousness." (2 Corinthians 9:10)

Distraction During Prayer

Question:

I get annoyed with myself when I am distracted while I pray. Is it a sin?
How can I be more attentive?

Answer:

The mind is a marvelous and complex thing, producing amazing thoughts, images, wisdom and inspiration. Yet at times it is like a two-year-old: it does not follow directions, does what it wants and loves to tell us "no!" This is probably the oldest and most common problem in the spiritual life—dealing with distraction. It comes in all forms: good intentions forgotten, wandering thoughts at Mass, daydreaming, etc.

A little poem says it all:

When the soul begins to pray,
the brain always wants to play!

There are many ways to handle distractions. If we are distracted by thoughts about our families or friends, we should pray for them. If we lose our focus, we need just "re-collect" ourselves. If some worry or concern just won't leave our mind, then we deal with it and come back to prayer or make it part of our prayer. And when words just won't come, the only prayer we might offer is our presence, our suffering, and our desire to be close to the Lord. Most importantly, we need to be patient with ourselves. These things are not sinful, but reminders of our human frailty. Our weaknesses and good efforts are all acceptable to God, who reads the love in our hearts and the good intentions of our minds.

REFLECTIONS

RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

Mini reflection: Our failure to understand is not a poverty. It is a gift. It propels us constantly back to the wellspring of our glorious Faith — to Scripture, to Tradition, to the in-dwelling of the Holy Spirit which sustains each and every one of us who dare to believe.

The Gift of Not Understanding

I once listened to Bishop Daniel Flores — a renowned scholar and prelate — give a 70-minute talk on the Trinitarian nature of God. In those 70 minutes, Bishop Flores said a lot of eloquent things. But what that really landed with me was not any group of words, but a single gesture.

Defining hypostasis, the term we use for the “the reciprocal dynamic relations that constitute distinct identities within the Godhead” (yes, I am using his words because I could never, in a million years, trust my own) Bishop Flores said “the Father and the Son are true God, but the Father is not the Son, and the Son is not the Father. How not? Different hypostasis.”

And here his eyes grew wide; he turned his head and opened his hands, drawing back as if from a spooked horse. The implication was clear: Any further than this, I dare not go.

I’ve never felt so seen.

Sometimes, I make the mistake of thinking that I am unique in my inability to understand the great mysteries. Sometimes, I despair that I am not a “better Catholic” — one who will rush headfirst into the crosshairs of a hard question, confident in the words that come immediately to my lips.

But when I saw Bishop Flores flinch at the thought of defining how, exactly, the Son is not the Father, and vice versa, I remembered that only fools rush in where angels fear to tread.

This Sunday, friends, take heart: our failure to understand is not a poverty. It is a gift. It propels us constantly back to the wellspring of our glorious Faith — to Scripture, to Tradition, to the in-dwelling of the Holy Spirit which sustains each and every one of us who dare to believe.

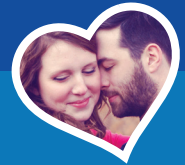

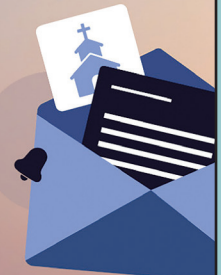
