GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

June 14, 2026
11th Sunday in Ordinary Time
Matthew 9:36-10:8

A few years ago, I met a woman in my parish who was a successful lawyer. Yet in her free time, she poured her energy into a nonprofit she founded to advocate for children with special needs. When I asked what inspired her, she spoke of her niece, who was born with disabilities. Her niece was both a glorious gift and a constant challenge. Out of that painful, beautiful experience, she felt called to create something lasting for other children and parents. The nonprofit thrived, not because she had mapped it all out, but because she was deeply moved to act.

In today's Gospel, Jesus is "moved with compassion" for the crowd, for they were "like sheep without a shepherd." (Matthew 9:36) So he calls his disciples, ordinary men with no special qualifications, and sends them to heal, preach, and cast out demons. Their mission flows not from their skills but from his authority and the Spirit's gifts.

The Second Vatican Council teaches that the Spirit continually pours out charisms, special graces for the good of the Church and the world (cf. Lumen Gentium 4 & 12). These often arise from the unfolding of our lives: from what breaks your heart, what fills you with hope, what suffering has shaped you. The Spirit works through those very experiences to equip us with gifts that build up others.

What is your charism? Well, what needs around you call you to loving action? This could be where Christ is sending you. Allow your heart to be moved like Christ's. Then get to work.

Y cada uno de nosotros lo debe hacer con un corazón abierto, con una actitud misionera; nuestra oración no debe limitarse solo a nuestras peticiones, a nuestras necesidades: una oración es verdaderamente cristiana si también tiene una dimensión universal" (Papa Francisco, 7 de julio de 2019).

Por lo tanto, urge que colaboremos con Dios de alguna forma: "Rueguen, pues, al dueño de la cosecha que envíe trabajadores a recoger la cosecha" (Mateo 9:38).

Parish Registration

Question:

Why is it so important that we register in a parish? Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Answer:

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, Confessions, and devotions are planned and scheduled.

Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.

St. Damien, serving others in need. We knit and crochet warm hats, scarves, gloves, blankets, loveys, and layette items to donate to various organizations at SJA. We

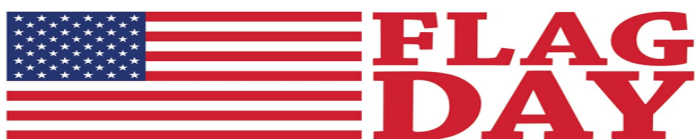

Discerning Vocations

Question:

What does it mean to discern a vocation?

Answer:

The word vocation comes from the Latin word vocare, meaning “to call.” A vocation is a calling or invitation from God to serve in a particular way. For Catholics, that calling might be as a priest, sister, or married person. Vocation is the way we respond to the invitation to share in God’s grace and witness to God’s love in the world.

Discerning a vocation is the process in which we pray for God’s guidance. We listen for God’s message that is often quiet and unassuming in a world filled with noise and distractions. We look at our gifts and talents, seek the advice of others, examine our motives, and listen to see what God is asking of us. The goal of discernment is to follow what the Lord wills, not what we think is the best idea. Many men enter a seminary to discern if that is their vocation, only to discover that their calling is to marriage.

Others have resisted the idea for long periods of time, until finally they could resist no more. Some great saints have described that dilemma. Vocation is a human process of divine origin, and each of us must strive constantly to hear the call of God in our lives.

Sin began with a lie.**

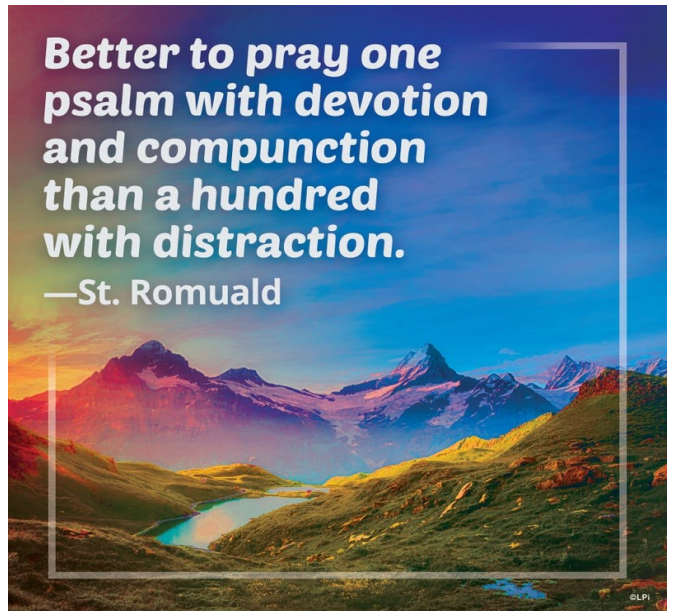
It was a lie that Satan told Eve in the Garden of Eden, and it was by doubting God’s faithfulness — by thinking God to be a liar — that the fall of man came about.

Therefore, if we belong to God, we must live truthfully — in small matters and in large ones, so that the witness we bear to the ultimate Truth of God shall always be taken seriously. “Witness is an act of justice that establishes the truth or makes it known,” says the Catechism (CCC 2472), which also calls the act of martyrdom “truth written in letters of blood.” (CCC 2474)

When Ananias tries to deceive the Christian community and secretly hoard wealth for himself, Peter tells him he has “lied not to human beings, but to God.” (Acts 5:4)

Better to pray one psalm with devotion and compunction than a hundred with distraction.

PARISH BEAUTIFICATION UPDATE

Parish Beautification Update! Since July 12, 1979 our parish of Saint Joan of Arc has been leading souls to Christ in very humble beginnings. Fast forward to 47 years later, our parish remains committed to fostering a family of faith called to live the love of Christ. In doing so, Christ's disciples are formed through the encounter in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration, forming young people to live a sacramental life and teach our students in our Preschool & Kindergarten. Adults seeking truth walk among us in the Order Christian Initiation for Adults, various events and activities foster fellowship and community. Many of us have experienced a gracious need for healing in body and soul. When time has come to finish this mission on earth, our loved ones were offered a Christian burial fitting for an anointed one.

After all these years, our buildings have endured a lot of wear and tear as a result of ordinary use. We strive to be good stewards of the sacrificial offerings to have our building stand. Now we face several challenges with our buildings as they are in need of repair and continued care and maintenance for the future.

Our Parish Beautification collection will focus on these repairs for the next six months and I am personally inviting you to help with a sacrificial offering of at least \$100 a month for the remainder of the year. If you are blessed to offer more, praise God for placing His Church first, it tells God I trust Him.

Below you will find the approximate costs of projects that need to be accomplished as soon as possible. The plan is to utilize our savings to cover the costs up front. However, we need to replenish our funds as we have additional building concerns in the future.

- Fire Alarm: repair in the church, Weidner Hall, preschool system ~\$85,000
- Roof Repair/Replacement: entire Weidner Hall roof replacement ~\$126,729
- HVAC: one unit replaced in the church (2026) ~\$70,000
- Another Church unit plus Santa Maria Hall unit (2027) ~\$120,000
- Church Floor Repair: replace broken tiles & weak areas ~\$7,000

Al hacerlo, los discípulos de Cristo se forman a través del encuentro en el Santo Sacrificio de la Misa, la Adoración Eucarística Perpetua, la formación de los jóvenes para que vivan una vida sacramental y la enseñanza a nuestros alumnos en nuestro preescolar y jardín de niños. Los adultos que buscan la verdad caminan entre nosotros en el Orden de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos, y diversos eventos y actividades fomentan el compañerismo y la comunidad. - Reparación del piso de la iglesia: reparación del piso de la iglesia (approx: \$7,000)

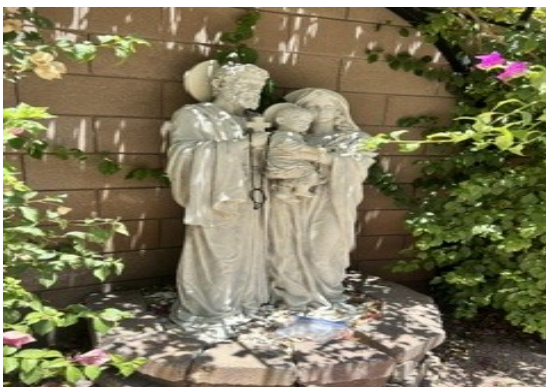

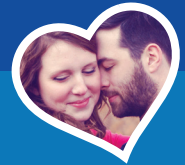

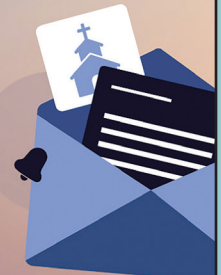
